We provide a safe, fun space every Monday for young adults with mild to moderate learning disabilities to meet friends, stay health and fit and take part in a blend of inclusive football, multi-sports and indoor games such as table tennis and snooker. We have use of the indoor space and the astro outdoors. We are running a Sport England programme from the 3<sup>rd</sup> February which also provides opportunities for participants to gain confidence and skills which may eventually lead them on to work or volunteer opportunities in sport if they wish.

**Role overview:** As a volunteer Inclusive Sports Support Assistant, you will play a vital role in ensuring the smooth deliver of our sports and social sessions. Your enthusiasm, eagerness to learn and friendly demeanour will contribute to creating a positive and inclusive atmosphere for our participants.

- **Assist Staff and Coaches:** Work alongside our dedicated coach staff to support the delivery of the inclusive sports and social sessions.
- **Participant Engagement:** Engage with young adults with learning disabilities, ensuring a welcoming and inclusive experience during both indoor and outdoor activities.
- **Activity Support:** Assist with a variety of activities, including football, pool, table tennis, and other multi-sports and games promoting active participation and enjoyment in a safe environment.
- **Supportive Presence:** Be an approachable and positive presence, fostering a sense of belonging for all participants.

- Eagerness to learn and adapt in a dynamic environment.
- Approachable and friendly.
- Ability to engage and communicate effectively with individuals with learning disabilities.
